

# 2010 PULL RULES

1. All Pull Committee decisions final including situations not included in these rules.
2. No drivers under 18 unless 16 or over with written permission from parent or guardian for Sept. 5th/ June 14 & July 11 PULLS-12 years old with tractor experience, their own tractor, Antique Classes ONLY
3. Antique and classic up to 1956. **MUST BE STOCK/ Semi Modified 1959 and older**
4. Officials only on track
5. Top 3 tractors in class may be checked for RPM.
6. All tractors must weigh out and have drawbar height checked.
7. Tractors may pull in more than one class, but no more than 2 pulls per tractor. (One award per tractor per class)
8. Stock engines only
9. No manual over-riding of govenors. (10% over standard engine speed only)
10. One restart within 20 ft. of pull attempt
11. 3 MPH speed limit
12. Pullers must obey flagman
13. No Jerking. Start with a tight chain.
14. Tractor pulls in 1st or 2nd gear. No shifting while pulling
15. No use of torque amplifier/ except in semi-modified classes
16. Tractors must stay within boundaries.
17. Tractors will be stopped if holes are dug.
18. Unsafe operators will be disqualified.
19. Drivers must stay on seat with one hand on steering wheel.
20. Raising front end over 30" during pull will be disqualified.
21. No fuel leaks. Tractor will be safety inspected.
22. 2 Wheel drive only. No duals or chains. Steel wheels will pull last in class.
23. Maximum tire size for standard tractors 18.4 by 34 Row Crop 15.5 by 38/ except in semi-modified classes **NO CUT, SHAVED, GROUND EDGES, or Radial Tires In any class.**
24. 18" maximum height of solid hitch or drawbar
25. 18" minimum drawbar length from center of axle to point of hook. (Modified hitches allowed if they fit specs. of rule 24 & 25)
26. No turbos or blowers
27. Any parts falling off during pull will disqualify tractor.
28. No external weights/ except semi-modified classes
29. Arguing or use of foul language will disqualify drivers.
30. No alcoholic beverages before, during or after pull.
31. All hitches must be made stabilized with struts to not allow rotation.
32. **Mandatory Functional Engine Kill Switch installed. (no switch-no PULL)**
