You must have a valid driver license and be 16+ old.

**Parking for Tractor Pullers at White Star during Fall Show (You MUST display to be eligible to pull).**

Pulling will begin on Friday night – Sept 3 with registration at 5 p.m. at the gray SCRAP barn and conclude on Saturday. A new feature – if you wish – you can park your pulling equipment at/near the track for the entire weekend. There will be a designated area. Remember, this is the pullers option. Or, you may park in the exhibit area and drive your tractor over to the pull area.

**Golf Cart Registration – Register EARLY!**

Your golf cart must be on White Star property to be registered. Glen Boss will be registering beginning Wed. noon thru Friday. He will be located near the gray SCRAP barn. Beginning show morning, Saturday, Sept 4, all carts will be registered at the entrance gate off Twp Rd 60. No change in qualifications – see show flyer accompanying this newsletter.

**CAMPING AND DISPLAY ITEMS REVIEW:**
