Fall Show Registration Booth - Anna Markley, Chair

1. Register your display/equipment.
2. Register your camping site.
3. Purchase or renew your SCRAP membership for 2011 (\$10.00 each)
(Current registration expires midnight – Sept 3, 2010).
4. Pick up a program for the weekend.
5. **NO BID Numbers** will be sold at the Registration Booth (go to Baker-Bonnigson in auction area).
6. Registration Barn will be located to South of the Red Barn (opposite side from last year).

Parking for Tractor Pullers at White Star during Fall Show (You MUST display to be eligible to pull).

1. **Pulling will begin on Friday night – Sept 3 with registration at 5 p.m.** at the gray SCRAP barn and conclude on Saturday.
2. A new feature – if you wish – you can park your pulling equipment at/near the track for the entire weekend. There will be a designated area. Remember, this is the puller's option. Or, you may park in the exhibit area and drive your tractor over to the pull area. **Pulling is for tractors that are on the grounds for the show and not brought in just to pull.**

Golf Cart Registration – Register EARLY!

1. Your golf cart must be on White Star property to be registered.
2. Glen Boss will be registering golf carts beginning **Wednesday, September 1 at Noon thru Friday, September 3.** He will be located near the gray SCRAP barn.
3. Beginning Show morning, Saturday, Sept 4, all carts will be registered at the entrance gate (off Twp. Rd. 60). No change in qualifications – see: [show flyer](#) on web page or accompanying this newsletter.

Camping and Display Items Review

1. **Parking of campers/exhibitors will begin after 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Sept 1.**
Escorts will take you to your places.
2. All campers **MUST** register at the Registration Booth.
3. **You MUST have an Exhibit (in the Exhibit area) to Camp** for the weekend.
Cost is \$20.00.
4. Campers with pets (**Pets MUST be kept leashed at all times**) at campsite.
5. No walking around the show area with pet on/off leash.
6. Non-exhibitors will need to utilize area public campsites.
7. **No Early Marking–Off of Camp sites or Display Areas.**
